DAILY SCHEDULE—School Year

3 p.m. - 4p.m. - Homework, Free Play, Relax
Any child with homework is required to get their homework completed at Extended Day before heading to activities.

4 p.m. - 4:10 p.m. - POW WOW

Transition time where students are told about their choices for the afternoon, and are given additional information on the monthly and weekly activities that are happening at the program.

4:10 - 5:15 - Activity Time

This time can include but is not limited to:
Crafts, Gym, Library, Workshops, Free Choice, STEM enrichment

5:15 - 6:00 - Clean up - Free Time

Relax, play games, read, students free time



PROGRAM HOURS



The Quabbin Extended Day Programs operate before and after school during the academic school year. The program is open on Professional Development Days, Early Release Days, February and April vacation weeks. The program closes following the school calendar for most holiday closings including Thanksgiving break & winter break. The program does close on snow days or reasons for school closings that are beyond our control. The program offers an 8 week summer camp open to all students in the district entering kindergarten through 6th grade and includes a Jr. Counselor program for students ages 13 - 15. The summer program operates out of the Hubbardston Center School Location.
